ADM donates \$5K to Dosher Foundation

SOUTHPORT—Archer Daniels Midland recently donated \$5,000 to Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation. The community engagement grant is for the purchase of equipment for the hospital and other support for the Dosher Foundation.

“It is great to have local corporations support efforts to improve the health and healthcare of our community. ADM’s investment in the community where it does business and where its employees live should prove to be a great return on the investment,” Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation President Lynda Stanley says.

The Dosher Foundation is a 501(C)(3) not-for-profit organization which has taken on the mission of enhancing the quality of healthcare for the people within the service area of Dosher Memorial Hospital by seeking and allocating philanthropic funds.

The purpose of the Foundation is to obtain funds through charitable giving, to administer those funds, and to allocate them to Dosher Hospital. These funds are used for the purpose of enhancing patient care, healthcare research, providing health-related education, and purchasing clinical equipment and facilities.

The donation was given through ADM Cares, a social investment program that directs funds to initiatives and organizations that drive meaningful social, economic and environmental progress worldwide. The program focuses on three areas: supporting the responsible development of agriculture, improving the quality of life in ADM communities, and fostering employee giving and volunteer activities.

The \$5,000 was part of the nearly \$81,000 raised by the Foundation through its sixth annual gala, announced last month.
