### **ADM donates \$5K to Doshier Foundation**

SOUTHPORT—Archer Daniels Midland recently donated \$5,000 to Doshier Memorial Hospital Foundation. The community engagement grant is for the purchase of equipment for the hospital and other support for the Doshier Foundation.

“ADM supports a wide range of programs in the community, and we’re pleased that Doshier has earned the company’s support for another year,” Doshier Memorial Hospital Foundation President Lynda Stanley says.

The Doshier Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization that obtains donations through charitable giving, administers those funds, and to allocates them to Doshier Hospital. These funds are used toward enhancing patient care, healthcare research, providing health-related education, and purchasing clinical equipment and facilities.

The donation was given through ADM Cares, a social investment program that directs funds to initiatives and organizations that drive meaningful social, economic and environmental progress worldwide. The \$5,000 was part of the \$60,000 raised by the Foundation through its seventh annual gala, held earlier this year.
