- Highlights include but are not limited to:
  - Assets at fair value \$3.7M
  - > Plan Trustee is Fidelity Management Company.
  - > No identified internal control issues
  - > No significant deficiencies.
  - > No disagreements with Management.

### Operating & Capital Budget Year Ending Sept. 30.2017

### **Operating Budget**

- The Finance Committee met to review the Operating and Capital Budget FY Sept., 30, 2017 and indicated that it was reviewed in detail.
- Assumed Revenue included but not limited to:
  - Increase in swing bed program.
  - Growth in lab and imaging.
  - Slight growth in clinics.
  - Payor mix shift.
  - Inpatient flat.
  - Reduction due to Nursing Center expenses not assumed.
  - Price increase of 3%. (Note: a 3% increase translates to approximately \$100K in profit)
  - Increase of service programs.
- Assumed Expenses included but not limited to:
  - Expenses assumed highlights included but not limited to:
  - Salary and benefits no change and includes a provision for 2% merit increases and 2% retirement plan investment.
  - Purchased Services such as coding and JC projects
  - > Supplied for 340B program and volume implants
  - Wellness Center Leases and Utilities
  - Interest on loans with USDA and BB&T
  - Depreciation of Wellness Center and 2017 capital.

It was noted that not having the Nursing Center in the finances,
