Key points in the reasons for opposing the CON were outlined. Over 500 letters were signed and presented to the Commission. Lynda Stanley spoke on the progress and noted it is the largest endowment in Dosher history. Tom Siemers outlined the next steps. It was noted that there will be need for a coordinator to be hired as well as a Board member liaison selected to Chair our committee.
