Dosher to Close Long Beach Road Urgent Care Clinic, Brings Convenient Care Services to Wellness Center

Same day appointment availability will be offered at the Dosher Wellness Center location.

SOUTHPORT— Friday September 25th will be the last day that the Dosher Urgent Care Clinic operates at 4222 Long Beach Road. The convenient, same-day care for minor illnesses and injuries, which has been offered at the Long Beach Road location, is relocating to the Dosher Wellness Center, and reopening on Monday, October 5th, 2020, as Dosher Convenient Care.

The Dosher Convenient Care, which, like the Urgent Care, will treat common, nonemergency medical conditions, will offer extended hours for patients, operating Monday through Friday, 8:00 am – 6:30 pm. Convenient Care at the Wellness Center will enable patients who require lab and x-ray for concise diagnosis to have access to these services on site until 3:30 pm.

In March of this year, the Dosher Urgent Care began to operate as a "call ahead" clinic for the safety of patients and staff due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dosher Convenient Care at the Wellness Center will continue to operate in this capacity, requiring patients to call ahead.

The Dosher Wellness Center, which is also the site of the family medicine practice of Dr. Leigh Vaughan, Dr. Kristos Vaughan, and Katie Pardee, ANP-BC, is located at 3009 Medical Plaza Lane, in Southport, directly adjacent to the SeaSide Gate of St. James, about 1 mile south of the Midway Road/211 Intersection.
