SOUTHPORT, NC - The J. Arthur Dosher Memorial Hospital (Dosher), a critical access community hospital located in Southport, NC today announced that its CEO Tom Siemers will step down, effective February 28, 2020.

Siemers joined Dosher in November, 2012 and during his tenure, the hospital has made significant advancements and received many state and national awards to include: 5 Star Patient Experience rating from the federal government based on patient surveys (awarded to only 7 hospitals in North Carolina), Press Ganey Guardian of Excellence Award, construction of new \$11 million inpatient unit, upgraded equipment and added new technology to include 3-D mammography, MRI and spine surgical service, designed and built Dosher Wellness Center, started Dosher Primary Care Network, and recruited multiple physicians to our area.

"It has been my honor and privilege to serve as CEO of Dosher Hospital," said Siemers. "I am proud of the progress we have made and am especially thankful to the Dosher team for their dedication and care for our community during my time here. This hospital, employees and volunteers will always hold a special place in my heart."

Dosher Board of Trustee's Chairman, Robert Howard said, "On behalf of the J. Arthur Dosher Hospital Board of Trustees, we sincerely appreciate Tom's years of dedication and service to the hospital, as he helped us navigate the changes in healthcare for Smithville Township. We wish for him the very best the future holds."
