Dosher Adds Portable X-ray Unit with Cannon Grant

SOUTHPORT—The Dosher Memorial Hospital Diagnostic Imaging Department has put a new portable digital X-ray unit in use, with the help of a \$100,000 grant received by the Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation from The Cannon Foundation, a private foundation based in Concord, North Carolina focused on health care, higher education, and human services across North Carolina.

The new unit, in which a digital imaging technologist participated in all phases of design, is more compact and easier to maneuver, in addition to offering improved quality over the 20 year old unit it replaced. The portable unit will be used to support the Emergency Department and bedside images of patients who are unable to be transported to the X-ray Department.
