**Doshier Foundation receives \$25,000 grant from Louis Bacon's Orton Foundation**

SOUTHPORT—The Orton Foundation, the North Carolina affiliate of Louis Bacon's Moore Charitable Foundation, has presented the Doshier Memorial Hospital Foundation a \$25,000 grant for the hospital's Emergency Department, which treats more than 13,000 patients per year.

The funds will go toward purchase of an infrared vein finder and patient transportation equipment.
