Dosher Foundation capital campaign reaches 90% milestone

SOUTHPORT—Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation's major gifts fund drive has raised \$1.8-million of its \$2-million goal.

At an update meeting in June, Robert Howard told Doshier Foundation supporters that he and his wife, Becky, are honored to co-chair the "Helping Hands for a Healthy Community," campaign and that it's an experience they will always treasure.

"The campaign is a success and the opportunities for Doshier to succeed well into the future are enhanced as a result of continuing community support. On behalf of the campaign committee, it is quite a satisfying experience; however, we need to reach our goal. In response, the 100 guests on hand that day donated or pledged an additional \$15,000.
