Dosher Foundation receives \$378,000 from the Golden LEAF Foundation

SOUTHPORT— Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation has received \$378,000 in funding from the <u>Golden LEAF Foundation</u> for an on-site well water system. This will provide a water source for both potable (drinking) and non-potable water and will support critical equipment, boilers, chillers, cooling towers and chilled water systems in the event of a disaster or other loss of municipal water.

"I am extremely grateful for everyone that worked with Dosher to make the approval of this funding possible," said Lynda Stanley, President of Dosher Memorial Hospital and the Dosher Foundation. "A special thanks to Coastal Carolinas Health Alliance for their support and the Golden LEAF Foundation for their consideration. This back up water well will be a critical element in helping to keep patients safe and our hospital fully operational, in case of a hurricane or other event, which would inhibit our ability to rely on public resources."

"We were excited to support Dosher Memorial in their efforts to apply and install a back up well system," said Brian Piccirilli, Coordinator of Projects and Grants for Coastal Carolinas Health Alliance. "We engaged with Columbus Regional Healthcare System on a similar project in 2018 and saw an opportunity to support Dosher as well."

The Golden LEAF Disaster Recovery Grant Program is funded through appropriations by the State of North Carolina to the Golden LEAF Foundation to make grants to eligible entities to repair or replace damaged or destroyed infrastructure and equipment as well as for the infrastructure to support hazard mitigation resulting from Hurricanes Matthew, Florence, Michael, and Dorian.

"Golden LEAF is proud to help communities recover from natural disasters and mitigate future recurrences through the disaster recovery program," said Scott T. Hamilton, Golden LEAF president and chief executive officer. "A back-up water well will help Dosher Memorial Hospital continue essential healthcare services if access to municipal water is interrupted."
