## **Dosher Volunteers fund nurse communications system**

SOUTHPORT—Thanks to a \$68,000 donation by the Doshier Volunteers last year, Doshier Memorial Hospital has a new, high-tech phone system in the Patient Care Unit. It improves the efficiency of nurses and patient care technicians responding to patient needs.

“We’re now able to dial the nurses’ extension and relay information instantly, rather than walking around the unit looking for the nurse,” Patient Care Director JoAnn Turzer-Comness says. “The improved staff efficiency has been huge.”
