Dosher drug drop surpasses 460 households

SOUTHPORT—People discarded 12,664 expired or unwanted narcotic pills and 3,410 milliliters of narcotic liquids at Dosher Memorial Hospital's semiannual Operation Medicine Cabinet today. They did so by auto, foot and ferry, including one woman who says she drove from Wilmington. The total of 466 households represents a 16 percent increase from the February 2015 drug drop.

Dosher thanked Southport Police and the Brunswick Sheriff's Office for onsite law enforcement support.

The next collection of unwanted prescription medications by Dosher is set for Thursday, August 18, 2016.
