Dosher drug drop surpasses 500 cars/households

SOUTHPORT—People came in cars and trucks, on bikes and on foot discarding close to 13,000 narcotics and more than 3,100 milliliters of narcotic liquids at Dosher Memorial Hospital's semiannual Operation Medicine Cabinet today. The total of 520 cars/households represents a 30 percent increase from the last drug drop six months ago.

Dosher thanked Southport Police and the Brunswick Sheriff's Office for onsite law enforcement support.

The next collection of unwanted prescription medications by Dosher is set for Thursday, February 18, 2016.
