Dosher expands hours for Urgent Care clinic

Expanded hours for the clinic at 4222 Long Beach Road, Southport, start Easter weekend: Urgent Care will be open Saturday, March 26, 2016 from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. and Sunday, March 27 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

April 1 through May 1, Urgent Care will be open weekdays 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Saturdays 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.

May 2 through September 4, the clinic will be open weekdays 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., and Saturdays 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. On Memorial Day weekend, Urgent Care will be open Sunday, May 29, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and Monday, May 30, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. On Independence Day weekend, hours will be Sunday, July 3, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and Monday, July 4, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. On Labor Day weekend, Urgent Care will be open Sunday, September 4, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and Monday September 5, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

September 5 through 30, weekday hours will be 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and Saturdays 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
