SOUTHPORT—Digital tomosynthesis for the breast, or three-dimensional mammography, is now available at Dosher Memorial Hospital.

"Two-dimensional mammograms are good for identifying calcification in breast tissue, while 3-D provides radiologists a clearer view of overlapping tissue and improves detection of invasive cancers. Our mammography unit does both simultaneously," Connie Pitman, MHA, CNMT, director, Dosher Diagnostic Imaging, says. "It's the same high-tech equipment as used at larger hospitals."
