Doshier Foundation receives \$25,000 grant from Louis Bacon's Orton Foundation

SOUTHPORT— Doshier Memorial Hospital Foundation has received a \$25,000 grant from The Orton Foundation, the North Carolina affiliate of Louis Bacon's Moore Charitable Foundation, for the hospital's Emergency Department, which treats more than 13,000 patients per year, and which has earned two national awards for providing high patient satisfaction. The funds from this latest grant will go toward the purchase of a portable ultrasound machine.
