Dosher Foundation receives another \$25K grant from Louis Bacon's Orton Foundation

SOUTHPORT—Dosher Memorial Hospital Foundation has received a \$25,000 grant from The Orton Foundation, the North Carolina affiliate of The Moore Charitable Foundation, founded by Louis Bacon in 1992.

The funds will go toward the purchase of five vital sign monitors and a bladder scan instrument for Dosher Memorial Hospital's Emergency Department, which has earned two national awards the past two years for patient satisfaction.

"The Orton Foundation continues to recognize the high-quality care that Dosher provides the community and has supported the hospital with a total of \$105,000 over the past four years," Dosher Foundation Board Chair Barbara Boland said. The Dosher Emergency Department treats 13,000 patients per year.
