Dosher set to open outpatient health and wellness center

As construction nears completion, Dosher Memorial Hospital announces a public open house for the Dosher Wellness Center on Friday, August 26, 3-6 p.m.

The two-story, 26,000-square-foot medical complex near the west entrance to St. James Plantation, will house several clinical services on the first floor:

- Board-certified family medicine physicians Dr. Kristos Vaughan and Dr. Leigh Vaughan who are relocating from Dosher Medical-Long Beach Road.
- Cardiac Rehabilitation, which is relocating from the hospital and will nearly double in size.
- Satellite physical therapy and occupational therapy services.
- X-ray services.
- An indoor walking track for cardiac rehab and physical therapy patients, as prescribed by their physicians.
- A cardiology physician practice.
- An office for rotating physicians in other specialties.

Guests are welcome to meet the clinicians and tour the first floor of facility that day. Refreshments will be provided.

The second floor of the complex will be used for future expansion.

Construction of the Dosher Wellness Center was financed through a partnership of St. James and Summit Healthcare Group, a private developer, at a cost of \$6-million. Dosher is leasing the space from the partnership and invested another \$1.9-million to equip the facility for the specific health and wellness services offered.
