The Howe Street Construction Project in Downtown Southport has closed off through traffic to East/West 9th Street. This may impact your traffic pattern to certain Dosher Medical Clinics as well as travel time to those clinics.

Clinics and departments affected by the detours include:

- Dosher Medical North Howe (Dr. Minor and Dr. Newsom)
- Dosher Medical Atlantic Avenue (Dr. Ward)
- Dosher Medical Women's Health (Dr. Manrique-Kiniry)
- Dosher Medical -Southport (Dr. Bocook)
- Dosher Medical General Surgery and Endoscopy (Dr. Armstrong)
- The Dosher Wound Care Center
- Patient Pick up from the Dosher Patient Care Unit

If you are heading South on Route 211 into Southport (going toward the waterfront), follow these steps.

For Dr. Minor and Dr. Newsom:

- Follow the right pointing arrow at the detour at W. 10th Street.
- Make a left onto N. Lord Street
- Make a left onto W. 9th and their office will be on the left-hand side.

For all other Dosher clinics and Patient Care Unit pick up:

- Follow the right pointing arrow at the detour at W. 10th Street.
- Make a left onto N. Lord Street
- Make a left onto W. 8th Street. You will cross N. Howe Street and make a left onto N. Atlantic Ave and drive toward the back entrance of Dosher Hospital.
- The offices of Dr. Ward and Dr. Manrique-Kiniry will be on your left.
- The office of Dr. Bocook is directly adjacent to the back entrance of the hospital on your left. Patient parking spots are marked.
- Go straight to the back entrance of Dosher Hospital for Patient Care Unit pick up.
- For the Wound Care Center and Dr. Armstrong, make a left onto E. 9th street you may go around the "No Through Traffic" sign to park in the clinic parking lot.

From the Southport waterfront:

- For Dr. Minor and Dr. Newsom, take Lord Street to W. 9th.
- For all other destinations, take N. Atlantic toward the back entrance of Dosher.
