## More than 300 households participate at Dosher drug drop

SOUTHPORT—Motorists, cyclists and pedestrians representing 320 Southport area households dropped off 9,600 expired or unwanted narcotic pills at Dosher Memorial Hospital's semiannual Operation Medicine Cabinet today. The number of participants is more than double the amount from last April. Area residents also dropped off more than 2,400 milliliters of narcotic liquids. Total weight of the discarded medications was 197 pounds.

One dozen Dosher employees, a Dosher board trustee, and staff from New Hanover County Health Department, Brunswick County Sheriff's Office and volunteers from the sheriff's office collected the medications.

The next collection of unwanted prescription medications at Dosher is planned for Thursday, April 4, 2019.
