Volunteers roll out new shuttle vehicle at Dosher

SOUTHPORT—Patients and visitors at Dosher Memorial Hospital can now get a ride to and from the hospital parking lot across Fodale Avenue in a new electric car, thanks to the Dosher Volunteers.

The four-seat vehicle is equipped with seat belts, heater, headlights and tail lights, windshield wiper, and a flashing safety light atop the 2017 Polaris model GEM e4. It replaces a golf cart which had been in service for five years. Volunteers operate the shuttle service 7 a.m. to 1 p.m. weekdays.
